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The workshops will be delivered by Peter Ellerton - director of the University of Queensland Critical Thinking Project and a lecturer in critical thinking.

Peter's research focuses on developing an understanding of critical thinking and how to teach it. He is a consultant to the International Baccalaureate Organization in the design and implementation of science curricula, and is actively involved in promoting the public understanding of science.

He won the Australian Skeptics prize for Critical Thinking for his work in developing educational resources that promote critical thinking. Peter is a regular contributor to The Conversation website and has appeared on ABC Radio National's *Philosopher's Zone* and *Ockham's Razor* to discuss the teaching of philosophy and argumentation.
